Installation Guidelines

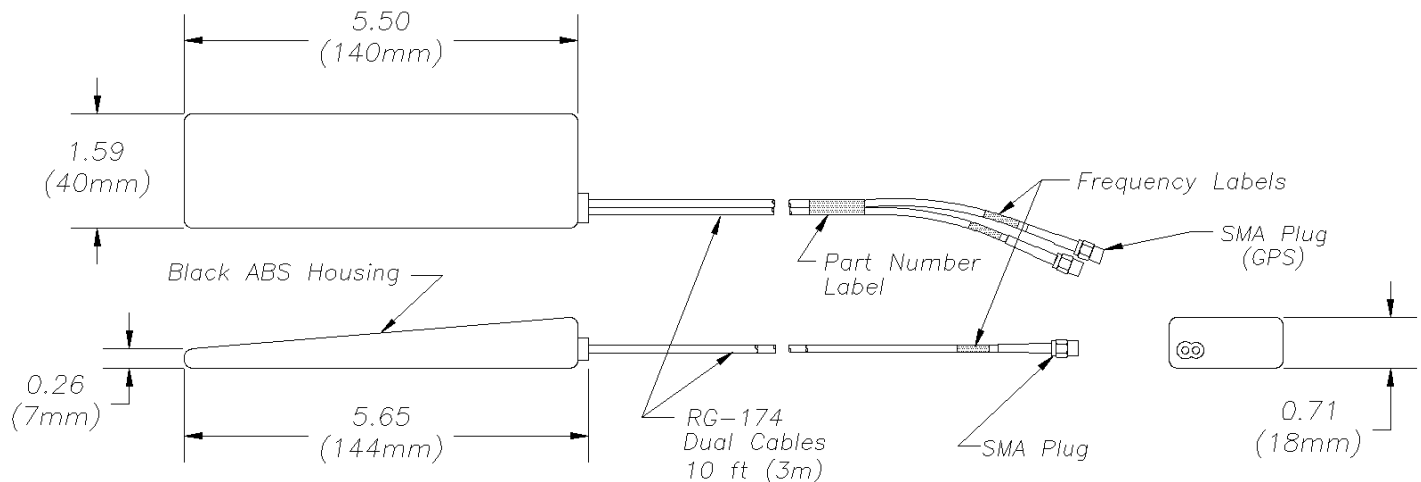
The CVW series antennas have slim profiles that allow them to fit into a wide variety of mounting locations. These compact antennas come with dual bonded RG-174 cable for both GPS & Data or dual bonded RG174 cable for GPS and RG-58 cable for data. Standard cable length is 10ft with SMA connectors. Other connector configurations are also available. Typical mobile installations include: underneath non-metal dashboards, underneath the carpet on the back deck, mounted on the windshield or rear window, on the back side of a rear view mirror, inside taillights or underneath plastic or fiberglass bumpers. For best antenna performance allow a 1/2 inch (13mm) distance away from any surrounding metal and at least 6 inches (153mm) away from other antennas. If GPS is included, the side labeled "GPS" must face upwards toward the sky. Models without GPS will have only one cable and can have either flat side face up. For covert or hidden installs be sure to position the

antenna in a manner so that any metal objects are beneath the antenna and not obstructing the view of the GPS antenna to the sky. These antennas can be mounted inside a NEMA box as long as the enclosure is made of a non-metallic material such as fiberglass or plastic.

Installation Steps

Before permanently mounting the antenna, clean the surface with alcohol. Peel off the paper from the two sided tape provided and stick the tape to the antenna. Then peel off the clear plastic tape and attach to your mounting surface. After mounting the antenna route the cables and connect them to your equipment.
