


Battery Tap Installation Instructions

High Current Connector for Electrical Automotive Accessories

INSTALLATION STEPS:

- Strip insulation 3/8" from end of HOT lead going to accessory
- Loosen short set screw, insert lead from accessory into hole in the Battery Tap then tighten set screw
- Place Battery Tap with lead attached onto HOT battery cable. Tighten long set screw.
 CAUTION: DO NOT ground the allen wrench
- Set screws should be tightened until tops are below the insulated surface of the Battery Tap
 <u>NOTE</u>: the set screw has a hollow tip which will puncture the cable insulation making electrical contact with the
 conductor
- ATTENTION: Always wear safety glasses and follow the proper safety practices when installing this accessory
