

## HD3 Installation Instruction

### INSTALLATION STEPS:

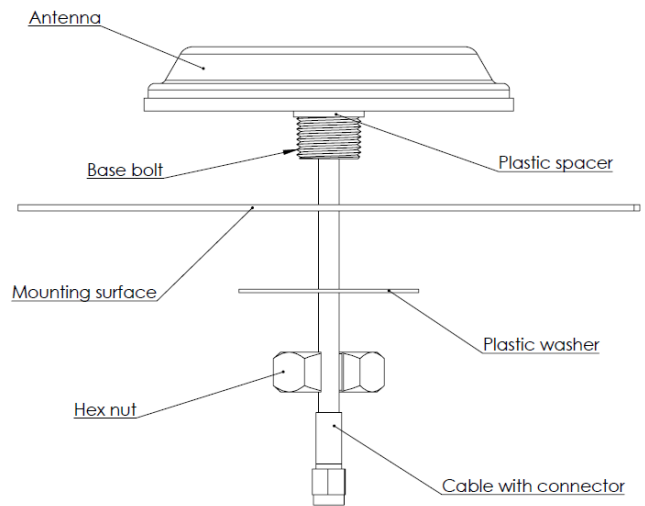
- Drill a 3/4" (19.1mm) diameter hole through mounting surface (1.5 sq-ft minimum ground plane recommended).
- Feed the cable(s) and base bolt through the hole. The plastic spacer should be isolating the base bolt from the ground.
- Slide the plastic washer up to the base bolt and then the Hex Nut.
- Tighten nut to 5 lb./ft. (6.8 Nm)

NOTE: DO NOT overtighten

NOTE: If the underside of the base bolt is exposed, sealing is required

OPTIONAL: If additional sealing is required, a bead of silicone can be applied to the gasket

- ATTENTION: Always wear safety glasses and follow the proper safety practices when installing this antenna.
