



LTM-IMK INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR FORD EXPLORER/INTERCEPTER MOUNTING KIT

INSTALLATION STEPS:

- Drill a 7/8" hole through the Ford Explorer roof directly in the center of two ribs.
- Peel paper off the ½" gasket to expose the adhesive. Center the gasket on the hole with the adhesive facing down and the flat edges parallel to the ribs.



 IMPORTANT: Before installing antenna, place two O-Rings over the LTM stud. The O-Rings will stay in place during installation. Make sure the O-Rings are flat against the gasket and each other.

- Remove all the paper from the gaskets.
- OPTIONAL: If additional sealing is required, a bead of silicone can be applied to the top of the ½" gasket as well as around the O-Rings.
- Feed the cables through the ½" gasket and the roof. Attach nut from the inside.
- Tighten nut to 5 lb./ft. (6.8 Nm).
 NOTE: DO NOT overtighten
